Doctor and Veterinary Surgeon on duty at the event.

Paper numbers will be used, so each rider will require a bib to display the number.

Bibs will be on sale at the event.

Closing date for entries Saturday 18th September 2010.

Full refund for withdrawals up to closing date. No refunds after this date.

Any entries accepted after 18th September will be charged an additional late entry fee of £10. Change of horse or rider will be charged £11.75 includes VAT.

Withdrawals by 2000 hrs on Wednesday, 22nd September, to 01 608 811070.

If either day is oversubscribed with entries and there is space on the other day, later entries may be moved to that other day.

If there are not enough entries for two days the entries will be amalgamated and we will run on Saturday 25th September.

CONDITIONS of ENTRY:

These horse trials will be run according to the rules of British Eventing, except where varied below and the making of an entry constitutes acceptance of those rules.

RULES:

Horse/ponies must be 5 years or older.

Horses/ponies must be over 137cm in height.

Riders must attain the age of 12 years in 2010.

Points won in B.E. Events will not apply.

Hard hats and boots with heels must be worn at all times when mounted.

Body protectors must be worn when competing in the cross country phase.

Hats must be tagged for all three phases.

Competitors are asked to wear medical arm bands.

Any horse or pony, which is considered by a Judge or the Organisers to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy, will be excluded from further competition without any refund of entry fee.

All dogs must be kept on leads.

ATV (quad bikes) and motor-bikes are not permitted at Tweseldown, unless specifically authorised by the Organisers.

COURSE WALKING:

The Cross Country Courses will be open for walking on Friday, 24th September at 2.00 p.m.

OBJECTIONS:

Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a £ 50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
